## FATHER MATHEW'S ROCK FORMATION

An immense rock slab with a width of 1,800 meters and a length of 6,000 meters. It is one of only three such formations in the world (the others are in Australia and Nairobi). Its surface is covered with rocks, mostly spherical, with dimensions of up to 7 meters in height. It opens for the public in the late afternoon and allows you to see the orange colors of the sunset among giant helmet-shaped rocks.






### TWOOL SACKS

An easy trail. Tourists can learn about medicinal plants like the Mulungu tree, a natural sedative, and the pine tree, excellent for treating wounds. Have a wild gastronomic experience by eating the fruit and the "xique-xique" cactus. The rock formation is 30 meters high and is divided into 8 blocks weighing 500 tons each. Tourists can climb to the top and enjoy a privileged view of the vegetation. The visit ends at the Portal of Light, a cave where the strategically positioned sun refracts colored beams of light based on the visitor's clothing color.






#### BRAVO ROCK FORMATION

An easy trail. This ancient rock formation covers 4,000 square meters and features various large rocks, caves, cacti, and lakes. It opens to the public at 4:30 AM so everyone can enjoy and see the sunrise from a height of about 30 meters. The trail includes viewing rock paintings, the Stone of Female Sexuality, the Center of Sacred Ceremonies where human sacrifices once took place, a cactus garden, and a Pleistocene Lagoon where fossils of prehistoric animals, such as a giant sloth, were found.







For three days, the Goat becomes the great King, even receiving the key to the city from the mayor. This tradition has been ongoing for more than 20 years and takes place during the Bode Rei Festival (Goat King Festival) in June.

The festival offers a rural tourist itinerary with cultural, ecological attractions, and free regional music.



# TANNERIES AND HANDMADE GOAT LEATHER PRODUCTS

The region is known for producing bags, sandals, wallets, hats, and decorative items made from goat and cattle leather. Several factories produce these items, which are sold throughout the country. At the tanneries, tourists can learn about two methods of tanning leather (artisanal and mechanical) and the entire process of preparing the product until it reaches the artisan.

There is also a craftsperson association nearby where you can purchase the products.





#### GASTRONOMY

The region is known for dishes made from goat meat. The food is tasty and stands out for its pleasant and colorful appearance. In addition to being easy to digest, it is extremely healthy. Goat meat has up to 70% fewer calories than red meats and up to 20% fewer calories than chicken. The region offers Goat Risotto, Northeastern paella, Goat Stomach, and cactus sweets.
